





#### From Our Nurse's Desk:

As you know, the Corona Virus is a real concern. Although there is no reason to panic; there are certain things that you can do to protect yourself and others by remembering to:

- Keep your environment as clean as possible by *daily* using disinfecting wipes with bleach, on all surfaces.
- Wash your hands frequently throughout the day with warm soapy water, including above your wrists - for as long as it takes you to sing "Happy Birthday", before rinsing the soap suds off.
